- Ensure students and instructors receive high-quality ground and flight instruction to build safe and capable pilots
- Assist in leading a bi-monthly instructor safety meeting with the Chief Instructor

- Assist in developing new and revising existing training courses, to meet the needs of our customers and stay in line with current regulations
- Assist in managing staff, including check instructors, CFIs, and ramp technicians
- Conduct progress checks and end of course checks with students as well as perform some primary instruction as needed
